 - These documents are confidential in nature, but the CRI Team are welcome to review the hard copies in our Jakarta office.
- 2. Where does the Angel Nickel project source nickel ore and other raw materials? If possible, please provide a list of the nickel mines from which the Angel Nickel project sources nickel ore.
 - Ore is sourced in and around IWIP, with all suppliers subject to a rigorous screening process and must be in full compliance with all laws. NIC does not currently supply ore to IWIP but is also working on mine acquisitions near our ANI operations with a view to these acquisitions being majority-owned mines that will become the major supplier to ANI as we have demonstrated our ability through receipt of the green PROPER (the official environmental rating from the Indonesia Ministry of Environment and Forestry) rating to exceed all environmental standards for our Hengjaya Mine in Central Sulawesi. As for the supplier list, it is confidential, but the CRI Team are welcome to review the hard copy in our Jakarta office.
- 3. To which companies does the PT Angel Nickel project sell the nickel pig iron it produces? Does Nickel Industries track downstream users of nickel it produces? If so, who are the downstream users of the nickel pig iron it produces at IWIP?

 All of the nickel produced from ANI is sold to the Tsingshan group.
- 4. How does Nickel Industries, Ltd. monitor its suppliers, including mines supplying nickel ore to the PT Angel Nickel project, for human rights and environmental abuses? How does Nickel Industries, Ltd. audit, evaluate, and/or monitor its suppliers?

 We do not operate any mines in or near IWIP, but we do operate a mine near IMIP that achieved the beyond compliance environmental rating (Green PROPER) in Indonesia last year. The nickel ore at IWIP is only sourced from mines that meet strict criteria and are in compliance with all Indonesian environmental and social laws.

Does Nickel Industries, Ltd. have a human rights policy beyond the statement on its website declaring, "Nickel Industries commits to respect human rights and the interests of cultures, customs and values of employees and communities affected by our activities." If so, please provide us with a copy of the policy. What steps is Nickel Industries taking to ensure this statement is being met by the PT Angel Nickel project?  - According to the Australia Indonesia Center (2021), our operations in North Maluku contributed to the higher GDP growth in the region, averaging 6.3% over the past eight years, comfortably above 5% nationally. Besides, this project also created job opportunities for more than 1,200 people in 2022. We will also empower local students through our university scholarship program with the view that the recipients will become the potential workforce for our company in the future, further strengthening the prioritisation of local employment in our operations.
